Service of NSS during natural calamities

During the natural calamity in Kodagu, NSS volunteers engaged in service work by serving food, cleanliness, distribution of materials, health care, and cultural programs at the refugee center continuously for a month, providing mental encouragement. He visited the natural calamity places and conducted a village survey and submitted a report to the District Collector. Also, during the calamity, he not only helped to carry the things in the house but also engaged in service work. More than 40 students participated.





Protection of elderly orphans and admitting to Orphanage

Volunteers from our college's NSS unit were involved in protecting orphaned elderly and putting them in old age homes. The volunteers noticed many orphaned elderly people lying on the road side around Gonikoppali, rescued them, settled them, dressed them in new clothes and took them to old age homes and left them. NSS volunteers are involved in the preservation of more than 6 orphans. More than 10 students participated.



Seed ball program

A seed ball making program was organized by the National Service Scheme Unit of our college. Out of which 2,000 seed balls were prepared and sown in the forest area of Thithimati. Volunteers placed different types of fruit seeds in lumps of soil and planted them inside the forest. This innovative program for environmental protection was successful one. More than 100 students participated.



Nature Studies and Trekking Camp

An Nature study and trekking camp was organized by the National Service Planning Unit. Western Ghats Zone Brahmagiri Tapalu, Nari Pele Betta, Kundabetta Chelavara Betta, Kabbebeta etc. were trekked by NSS students and they climbed the hill very interestingly. About Environment Under the guidance of environmentalist Chinnappa, Bose Madappa, an environmental study camp was conducted with the cooperation of forest officials. Every year 50 students participated in the trekking camp.



Vivekananda Jayanti Celebration

Swami Vivekananda Jayanti was celebrated on behalf of NSS unit. National Youth Day is celebrated every year at Sharda Ashram, Ponnampet. NSS students of our college participate in this program and participate in the program for procession from primary school to Sharda Ashram and also engage in service work of serving food to the public. More than 100 students participated.



Creation of Cauvery santhvana yojana Scheme

Cavery College Gonikoppalu, Kaveri College Virajpet, Kaveri Polytechnic College, Gonikoppalu, Kaveri Pre-University College Gonikoppalu and Virajpet have started a unit called Kaveri Santhvan Yojana in collaboration with these five colleges in which the students of the five colleges not only provide financial assistance to the volunteers who serve in emergency situations but also to the good volunteers who rescue and hospitalize in case of accidents. Apatbandhava is being honored with the award. More than 1500 students participated.



Folk dance and drama program

A folk dance and drama program was organized by NSS students. Participated in drama festival held in Rangayana, Mysore as winner of district level drama competition. Also, NSS students participated in Mysore Yuvadasara and got prizes. More than 40 students participated.



Amrita Community Scheme Programme

Government of Karnataka, Department of Youth Services and Sports, on behalf of the National Service Scheme, undertook the adoption program of 750 villages. In a program called Amrita Community Yojana, various villages are being adopted and service programs are being carried out. This project has the task of bringing the government facilities to the common people by conducting a survey by the students about the facilities available to the people in the rural areas. NSS students of our college are actively participating in this project and implementing the project. Ballyamandur village has been adopted and various programs have been organized. More than 100 students participated.



Village survey

A village survey program was conducted every year by the NSS unit, going to the houses in each village to create awareness about the schemes of the government and the facilities to be provided by the government and submitting a report to the local village panchayats. More than 100 students participated.



Shramadhana

Shramadhana program is being conducted in the college premises every weekend by the NSS unit of the college. Apart from this, volunteers are involved in service work by going to one village every year, cleaning the village and cleaning the school. More than 100 students participated.



Lecture programme

A lecture program on various topics is being organized by the NSS unit of the college. Environment protection, health protection, family welfare, consumption of nutritious foods, cleanliness, increase in status of women, emergency services, educational development etc. are

being created by inviting subject experts to give lectures to the students. More than 150 students are participating in this. More than 100 students participated.



Encouragement for rural sports

A rural sports event is being organized for the students and general public by the National Service Planning Unit. Every year, rural sports like tug of war, kuntabille, coconut shooting, blindfolded walking, pottery making, lagori volleyball etc. are organized in each village. Students and public are made to participate in the rural sports and awareness is being spread about the local games. More than 100 students participated.



Students in agricultural activity

The NSS students of the college were taken to the paddy field to engage in agricultural activities. E was told about the method of harvesting the crop and threshing the paddy. The students were enthusiastically engaged in the agricultural activity in the paddy field. This program was organized to create awareness about agriculture in this context where it is difficult for young people to participate in agriculture. Around one hundred students participated in it. More than 100 students participated.



A Garden built by NSS students

NSS students constructed a garden and flower garden in the premises of Government Senior Primary School, Beguru. The construction of this garden in a seven-day camp has won the appreciation of the villagers. Different types of flower plants have been planted in the garden. More than 100 students participated.



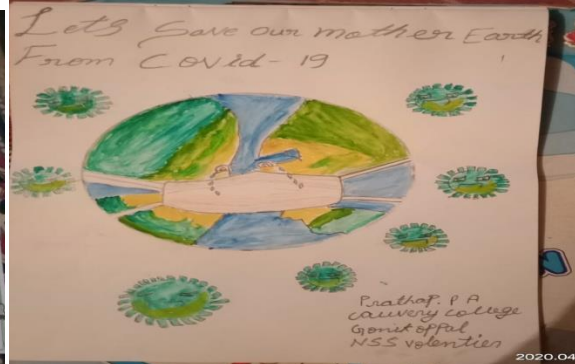
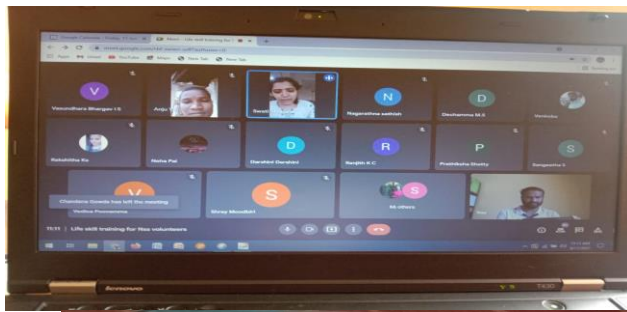
Cleanliness programme

According to the Swachh Bharat Mission, it is the duty of everyone to keep clean. Accordingly, NSS students not only clean the college premises every week, but also organized cleaning programs in places like Gonikoppa Bittangala, Kiraguru, Hattur, Kaikeri, Thitimati, Ponnampet, Virajpet etc. The task is shared. Every year around 150 students are involved in the cleanliness drive. On the occasion of Field Marshal Kariappa's birth anniversary, garbage lying on both sides of the road from Virajpet to Gonikoppa will be removed and cleaned. More than 100 students participated.



Awareness program in case of covid

During Covid, the NSS students of our college went to their neighboring houses and informed about the method of wearing masks and washing hands and also created awareness among the public by posting awareness posters online. Apart from this, an online awareness workshop was held to create awareness about Covid among the public, by creating posters and posting them on WhatsApp and Facebook, around 100 students participated. More than 100 students participated.



Service work at Kannada literature conference

NSS volunteers are involved in service work in literature conferences in Kodagu. Serving food to the public, instructing people to stand in queues, cleaning, registering, giving cultural programs, etc., have served as volunteers in Kannada Kodava literary conferences. More than 120 students have participated in this. More than 100 students participated.



Blood donation camp

A blood donation camp is organized every year by the NSS unit of our college. About 40 to 50 percent of the blood is donated. Also, students are involved in saving lives by donating blood to those who need blood on time. Everyone is prepared to do blood groups and serve in case of emergency Blood donation is organized every year and blood donation is done. More than 100 students participated.

Plantation program is organized every year by our college. Volunteers are involved in the plantation program in the college premises and at places outside the college. More emphasis is being given to environment conservation by planting trees in places like Thitimati forest area, Kiruguru Deva Kadu, etc. More than 100 students participated.



Celebration of national festivals

Every year national festivals are celebrated by NSS unit Independence Day Republic Day Gandhi Jayanti Vivekananda Jayanti National festivals are celebrated in the college every year on this occasion cleanliness program is organized in the college premises. More than 100 students participated.



Adoption village concept

Every year the concept of Adopted Village was promoted by the NSS unit of our college. Like one village per year, one village is selected every year and various activities are being conducted there. In the last five years, people are being made aware by

organizing programs in Bellur, Begur, Chirugur, Ballyamandur, etc. In these villages, many programs like construction of school premises, road repairs, painting of school buildings, construction of toilets, cleaning of drains, cleaning of temple premises are being carried out in collaboration with the public. More time is being given to the development of the village in this program in which around hundred students are participating. More than 100 students participated.



New Year Celebration at the Handicapped School

On behalf of the NSS unit, the tradition of participating in the disabled school and mingling with the students and making a new year has been developed. On the first day of the year, the work of cleaning the premises of the handicapped school, doing various psychological games and cultural programs for the students is being done on the first day of the year. Palibetta Thitimati visiting Bommadu schools and mingling with disabled students is unforgettable. More than 100 students participated.



A Survey of Tribal areas

A survey was conducted by the NSS unit of our college in the tribal colony of Thitimati. The students came to know the problems of the economically and socially backward classes and provided them to the local Gram Panchayat. The volunteers carried out door-to-door work on the schemes for the development of the underprivileged. About 80 scientists participated in it. More than 100 students participated.



Health checkup camp in rural areas

A health checkup camp was organized in rural areas by the NSS unit. People from the backward castes and classes of the village participated in this and underwent health check-up. In this camp held in collaboration with the Health Department, the health checkup of the elders and children of the village was conducted. Awareness was created so that students go to every house and get health check-up done. More than 100 students participated.



Children's Learning Program

NSS students went to schools and conducted a learning practice program with the aim of helping poor children to learn. NSS students ensured that the students were educated by teaching them. About 80 children went to school every week and taught lessons in this program which was organized for primary school children. He also taught the children how to sign by going to the songs of the tribesmen. More than 100 students participated.



Sadhbavana Day

Sadhbavana Day is celebrated every year by the National Service Planning Unit. Guests of various religions are invited and guided and Pledge of Allegiance is preached on the Goodwill Day. National sentiment is given importance by eradicating caste, caste and religion sentiments among the students. More than 100 students participated.



Radio programme

On behalf of the NSS unit of the college, a radio program is being organized to provide entertainment to the public through programs such as poetry, devotional song, folk song, short drama, and speech, and awareness message is being given to the public by giving a lecture on the environment on radio. More than 20 students participated.

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan programme

On behalf of the NSS unit, the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan program was being carried out, and garbage was removed from both sides of the road from Gonikoppali to Virajpet. From Virajpet, Maha Kottavas were cleaned in Swachh Bharat Abhiyan program. A cleaning program was organized in the area around Gonikoppal. More than 100 students participated.

Celebrating AIDS Day on behalf of NSS unit. Every year the District Control Unit Madikeri is providing awareness about AIDS to the students.
